#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE

## **FAR and DFAR Requirements for Suppliers**

## FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (FAR), DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DoD) FAR SUPPLEMENT (DFARS).

The following clauses set forth in the FAR and DFARS as in effect on the date of this purchase order, unless otherwise noted, are incorporated herein by reference. The listed FAR and DFARS clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in full text. Where necessary to make the clauses applicable to this purchase order, "Contractor" shall mean "Buyer" "Contracting Officer" shall mean "Buyer," and the "Government" shall mean "Buyer" or the "Government" whenever appearing in the clauses, unless otherwise noted. However, the words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the Prime Contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative and (2) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government. #### NOTES

Note 1: Unless the U.S. Government has either specifically identified technical data or computer software to be delivered under this Contract with less than Limited Rights (as defined in DFAR 252.227-7013), or has paid for the development of such software or technical data, it is understood and agreed by both Parties that this clause shall not be construed to mean that Seller will make available any drawings, manufacturing processes, software, inspection techniques or other items (collectively "technical data") which the Seller claims, and at Buyer's request can document, to have been developed at its own expense without the use of Government funds. Pursuant to DFAR 252.227-7013(k)(3), Seller reserves the right to deliver any such technical data developed by Seller at private expense directly to the U.S Government. Unless the delivery of technical data developed at private expense is otherwise provided for under the terms of the contract between Seller and Buyer, Buyer shall have the right at any time to request delivery of any such items for a fee and agreement on application of distribution statement to be negotiated in good faith by Buyer and Seller.

Note 2: Where necessary to make 252.222-7006 applicable to this purchase order "Contractor" shall mean "Seller" in 252.222-7006(b)(1). Seller shall include 252.222-7006 in all Subcontracts with Covered subcontractors, as defined in 252.222-7006(a), at all tiers.

Note 3: ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS - Seller shall, upon the request of Buyer, review Buyer's request to accept additional clauses and conditions as Buyer may reasonably deem necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the applicable Prime Contract(s) or with the provisions of amendments to such Prime Contract(s). Acceptance of such clauses and conditions shall not be unreasonably withheld. Seller shall allow for the incorporation of any government mandatory flow down changes that are required by statute, regulation, executive order or prescription through the validity period of this agreement.
